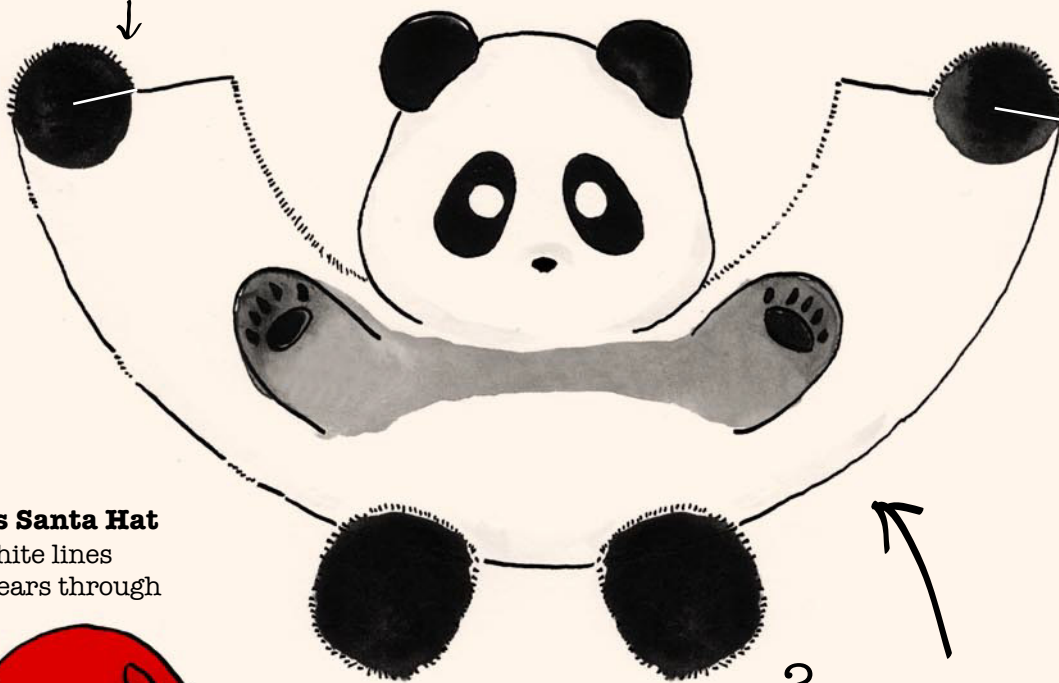


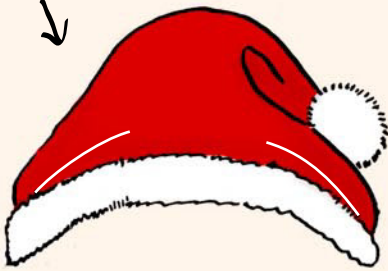
Hey... Thought I'd send some fuzzy little friends over and make sure that you have a Beary Christmas & Happy New Bears!

1. Cut along the outlines & the white lines

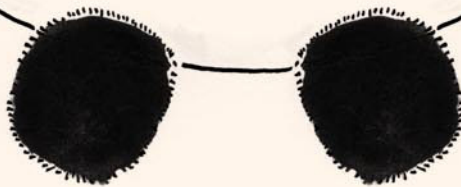


Polar Bear's Santa Hat

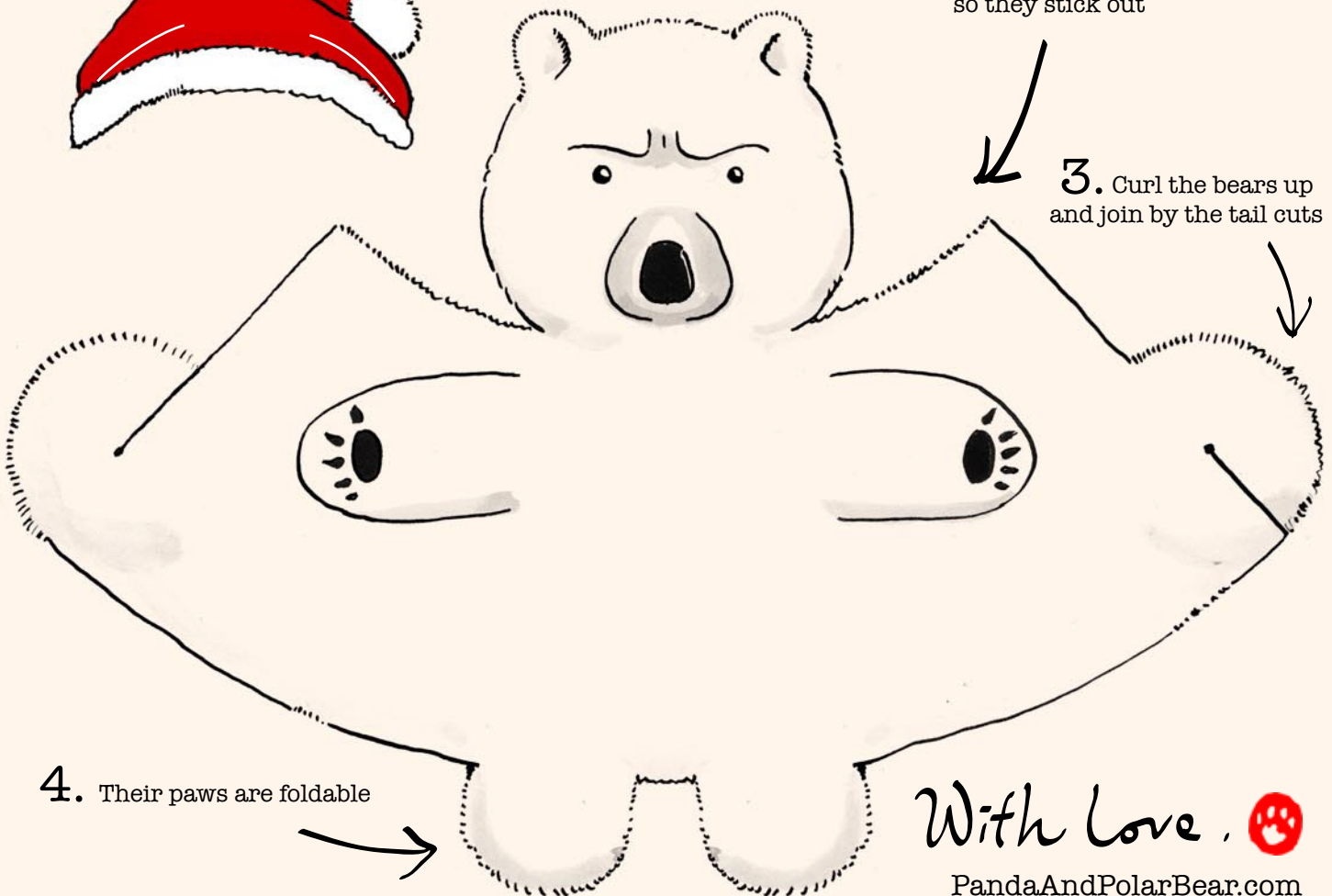
Cut the white lines and poke the ears through

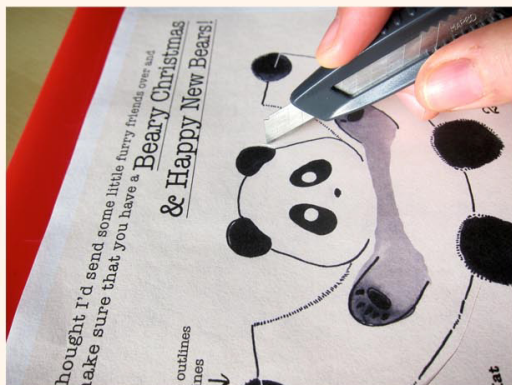

You don't need to be a crafting genius to make these bears, all you need is a knife or a pair of scissors :)



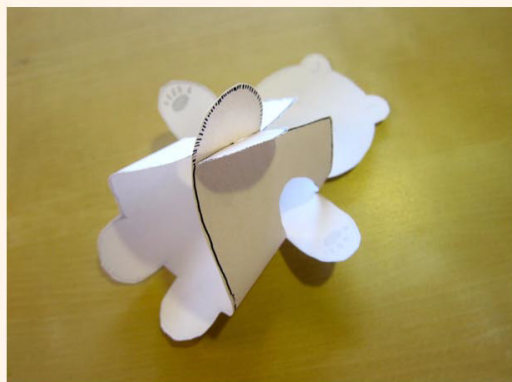
1.
